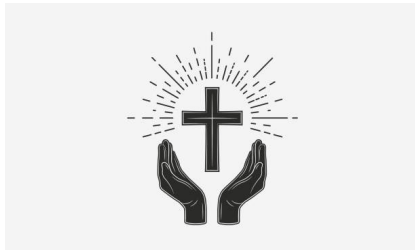

Fun Facts

In 1845 William Boate, an original settler, donated land on Lot 22, Concession 6 of the Township of Emily for an Anglican Church and Burial Ground. The new church was built on the corner of the lot. It was made of flat pine logs, measured 36' x 40, and was painted white. It was consecrated with the name of St. James the Apostle in September 1845. About 40 people attended every Sunday.
